Carolina For Kibera:

Kibera is East Africa's largest slum, located in Nairobi, Kenya. Home to approx. 1 million people in the space of one square mile, most residents subsist on less than \$2 a day and live without running water, electricity, or adequate sanitation facilities. 50% of Kibera's population is under the age of 18 and most residents have only a primary school education.

Carolina for Kibera was founded in 2001 by UNC undergraduate Rye Barcott and Kenyan community organizer Salim Mohamed.

Run by Kenyans and advised by American volunteers, CFK's primary mission is to promote youth leadership and ethnic and gender cooperation in Kibera through sports, young women's empowerment, and community development.

Our mission for this clinic is to provide local soccer players with a chance to learn about soccer as a development tool in Kibera while training with top UNC and national team players. All players involved – whether local youth, college and national-level players, or youth in Kibera – will unite through the shared love of soccer.
